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## 1. Login to your profile

All researchers who have actively agreed to transfer their data from Sqquid to PURE have automatically received their PURE username and password via email.

Users having a **PMU e-mail address** are able to log in to PURE using their PMU log in data.

Users without a PMU e-mail address receive their log in data in an PURE welcome e-mail.

After the first successful login, you will see this message:

#### Welcome to your personal user overview page in PURE!

Welcome to your personal research profile, which has been transferred from PMU-SQQUID if you have agreed to the data migration consent form. We kindly ask you to check and complete your profile and, if necessary, to contact pure@pmu.ac.at.

#### The first steps:

- You can update personal information using the 'Edit Profile' button above.
- The 'Add New Entry' button on the right allows you to enter new content to PURE.
- More information in your research profile will result in optimized search engine rankings.
- Training and support material is linked on the bottom right in your profile.

#### Further notes:

- Online Training will be offered to PURE users from January 2024. You will receive timely information regarding appointments and coordination (via email and directly in your PURE account).
- From now on, publication excerpts can only be created directly by Research Service employees. If necessary, we ask you to contact pure@pmu.ac.at.
- The PURE portal will go live in March 2024. The external view of PMU-SQQUID is still available.

# 2. Manage your profile


### Important for Editors

Please do not change any notification settings for emails, notifications, and tasks connected to the workflows (in the Editorial tasks category) of Research Output, Application, Award, Project, Facility/Equipment, and Person.

### 2.1. E-Mail settings


Pure email notifications will be sent to the email address you used to log in. For example, as a Researcher, you got an email when a new publication is added to your profile.

Here is an example of an email:




#### To manage the email settings:

1. Click on username in the header:



- 2. Navigate to *E-mail Settings* and select the event(s) in the Email message column you wish to modify. Click on the black triangle to expand the list of events.
- 3. In the *Email frequency* column, you can tailor the email frequency to your preferences:




4. Click Save to apply the changes.

### 2.2. Message Settings

Similar to the email settings, you can manage the messages that Pure automatically sends you when specific events occur.

Here is an example of a message (notification):




#### To manage the message settings:

1. Click on username in the header:



- 2. Navigate to *Message Settings* and select the event(s) in the *Pure message* column. Click on the black triangle to expand the list of events.
- 3. In the *Included* column, you can tailor the message frequency to your preferences. A black tick indicates an activated message. You can deactivate the message by removing the black tick(s):



4. Click on Save to apply the changes.

### 2.3. Task Settings

You can manage the notifications that Pure automatically sends you when a specific task occurs. For example, if a milestone is waiting to be completed.

Here is an example of a task notification:




#### To manage the task settings:

1. Click on username in the header:



- 2. Navigate to *Task Settings* and select the event(s) in the *Task* column. Click on the black triangle to expand the list of events.
- 3. In the *Show* column, you can tailor the message frequency to your preferences. A black tick indicates an activated message. You can deactivate the message by removing the black tick(s):



4. Click on Save to apply the changes.

#### 2.4. Trusted Users

A trusted user has the ability to assume control of your user account and perform all the tasks that you can within Pure, except for controlling other accounts with a trusted user status.

#### To add a trusted user:

1. Click on username in the header:



2. Navigate to *Trusted Users*, then click on the icon. Begin searching for the name of the trusted user you wish to add. You can add multiple trusted users.



3. Click on Save.

### **Important**

Even if you add trusted user(s), you can still monitor any changes they make. These alterations are recorded in the *Comments and History* panel.

To remove a trusted user click on the - icon:



## 2.5. Language settings

The language controls the language of the menu. The submission language controls the language of the data that will enter into Pure. It is your choice that the menu language and the submission language can be the same or different.

#### To change the language:

1. Click on username in the header:



 In the Profile tab under Language settings, select the language in the Language and or in the Default submission language field. German and English language options are made available by PMU.



3. Click on Save to apply the changes.

#### Tip

If you frequently enter content in both English and German, you can easily switch

between the current submission languages by clicking on the flag corresponding to your preferred language.



#### 2.6. Roles


The Researchers at PMU have been assigned a personal user (staff) role. The Editors and the Reporters of organisational units of PMU receive additional roles. Please contact the Research Management (pure@pmu.ac.at) if you encounter a problem with your role.

### To check on your role(s):

1. Click on username in the header:



2. In the Profile tab under Roles you can see all of your roles assigned to your profile:




## 2.7. Personal profile

Under the Personal tab, you can manage a wide range of information associated with your researcher profile. For example, you can add name variants, profile photo, ORCID, research description, and positions held outside of the PMU. You are responsible for all the information included in your personal profile. We recommend providing as much information as possible in your Personal profile.


Here is an example how to manage your name variants, for example, names before marriage or multiple middle names. This field also serves to improve accuracy in automated publication search.

#### To manage your name variants:

- 1. Click Personal in the header.
- 2. Go on Edit profile (located under the picture):




- 3. Click on the *Metadata* tab in the left navigation.
- 4. In the *Personal Identification* tab click on the *Add name variants* button to expand the *Name variant* area:



- 5. Enter the First Name and the Last Name you want to add, then click on *Create*. Click on the minus icon to remove the names. Click on *Edit* to update the names.
- 6. Click on Save.

The 'My public profile' link (located under your name) will allow you to access your profile in Pure Portal later, which will be launched in spring 2024. Therefore, the link has not been activated yet; **please refrain from using it:** 



### Your scientific work in numbers and graphs

Under your personal profile, your scientific work is visualized through numbers and graphs, including your research outputs, projects, research network, top co-authorships, and top organizational affiliations on research outputs.
